From the desk of **Leona Rega** Executive Director



As I begin my journey with the ministry of Human Life Services, I give praise to the awesome God we serve. I moved to this area in December of 2020 from Schuylkill County. Not feeling confident in these areas can trigger the feeling of fear and despair when discovering one is pregnant. I recall how the church has been instrumental in my life. It is in life-affirming steps that we place ourselves at the forefront of an important time in the world. Our mission and purpose are not always received well or understood.

In my devotions in II Samuel 22 we are reminded that God is our rock and fortress. In our faith, He girds us with strength to carry on when we are tired, and he delivers us to a place of peace just when we believe we have lost hope through persistent adversity. I give thanks to God that he has brought me here at a time such as this. I praise God for all of you and the support you have given to Human Life Services over the past 35 plus years with your time, talents, prayers, and advocacy. Looking to the future I seek your continued faithfulness for His glory as we continue to reach those who stand on the edge of a decision in the life of their unborn child.

Our mission remains the same as we work relentlessly to ensure we have volunteers and staff trained and ready to guide our clients. Please join us in our future. I hope to meet you at one of our upcoming events, the Open House in August, our annual Banquet, next year's Golf For Life, or even through a personal phone call and casual meeting.

Until then, I trust you will continue praying for our needs. I close with two of my favorite verses, may they bless you. As she answered the call to fill in over the past year taking on the responsibilities of our Client Services Manager, God has equipped her to fulfill this role. We are excited to see how He continues to bless our ministry through her leadership!

The Lord has been up to some exciting things here at Human Life Services. Our Care Program is meeting the needs of

men and women of varying ages in our community. While in these classes, clients earn baby bucks to spend in our boutique and get weekly one-on-one lessons with a client advocate. Let me share with you how amazing God is. In the past few months, we had three girls enroll in our pregnancy and birth classes. This isn't unusual, but what if I told you they all arrived at our center abortion minded and undecided if they could have their babies. They were hurting and confused. From the time they reached out to us, we were there walking through this journey with them and praying for them. Since each situation is different, we must be sensitive and listen to their hearts. Two of these women were in their 40s, so this was a difficult decision for them. Praise God for our staff and volunteers as we were able to offer options counseling and also had the ability to give them a free ultrasound, explaining what they were seeing. These three women chose life for their babies and are receiving the emotional, physical, and spiritual support they need through our classes. Thank you! Without your prayers and support, this service would not be possible. We ask that you continue to pray for us, as we reach out into our community. Let us be the hands and feet of Jesus to a world that needs him.
