The Battle IS the Lord's!

1 Samuel 17:47





From the desk of **Leona Rega** Executive Director



My siblings and I would often play rock, paper, scissors when deciding who was going to complete chores. There was quite often a feeling of defeat when I lost. Many times, a second and third challenge was presented when I wanted another shot at prevailing.

The battle on abortion has become like a game of rock, paper, scissors. Those who are defending life have cut through Roe vs. Wade. Those supporting termination of life tossed out a rock on the scissors with loosening restrictions on dispensing medication abortion; another challenge begins. For those of us working daily in the fight, there can often be a feeling of despair. Today, I want to remind us that the battle truly IS the Lord's. We know that when His people cry out together and are unified, He answers our prayers by taking command in the realms we do

not see. He uses us as His instruments to change hearts and minds. He places some in areas of example through personal testimony and sheds light in the darkest of corners. He raises up leaders and volunteers who felt ill equipped in the past by placing them exactly where they can be effective.

The 2021 PA state abortion statistics published in February 2023 showed 54% of abortions are achieved through medication taken at home. These drugs are Mifepristone and Misoprostol. The FDA approved these medications as scripts handed out over the counter at your chain or local drugstore. In some states, they are ordered through the mail and delivered directly to a doorstep without medical oversight. If you read Planned Parenthood's website, they explain how these drugs block a woman's progesterone hormone, prevent the fetus from growing, and induce cramping which causes the at-home abortion. They then continue to tell you this is safe, and no longer requires a follow-up visit with a woman's doctor.

This April, a Texas federal judge banned the sale of these medications in a decision that would span across the country. A rock was thrown down on the opposition! It stated the FDA's approval in 2000 did so using unsound reasoning and studies which did not support their conclusion that the drug was safe. However, days later, a U.S. district judge, in coalition with 17 other states, blocked the FDA from pulling the medicines from their approved list. Paper has now covered rock. As I write, the Supreme Court has granted a stay on the use of the pills, seeking for the lower courts to continue their proceedings first.

While the rock, paper, scissors battle continues in our courts, I encourage you to stand firm in defense of the unborn. God knows the best course of action for us as Christians. I see it daily at Human Life Services, through the volunteers who come to help, in conversations with young people learning and eager to advocate for the unborn, and in the generosity of our donors who help us reach those facing an unplanned pregnancy. These front lines are where we become like David. Using our words and actions of love, together we will defeat this giant with the Lord's blessing and help. The world will mock us, try to discredit us, and paint us as fools. But our God is greater! Stay vigilant.

Our ministry would not exist without the time and talents of our many volunteers! To show our heartfelt appreciation for each and every one of them, Human Life Services hosted a Volunteer Appreciation Dinner on April 18, and we were blessed by the presence of almost 100 volunteers and guests! York Alliance Church graciously donated their Student Center for our venue, and the delicious meal was catered by Jen Heasley, owner of Cooking with the Pros and maker of Sweet Mama's Mambo Sauce in Central Market. Our staff truly enjoyed the opportunity to serve our volunteers and show our love for them, as they do for HLS and our clients every day!

Did you know we have over 80 volunteers who give their time on a regular basis to Human Life

Services? This includes our board members, client advocates, front desk and administrative workers, building maintenance, yard care, and snow removal. All of our volunteers are very important to us! They help our staff limit outside distractions so we can focus on the mission set before us.

As of right now, we have 13 volunteers who serve weekly, 20 who serve monthly, 33 who help at our special events, 18 taking care of seasonal work, and 7 new client advocates in training.

We give God praise for new volunteers coming onboard so that we can add more clients into our Care Program. We know there are moments of frustration for new volunteers when a client doesn't show up or calls out sick at the last minute. Their travel time seems longer than the time spent at HLS. But God has laid it on their hearts to serve our organization. They may be here a few weeks before a client comes on a regular basis and even then, there is no guarantee that they will come faithfully every week. This is why our Care Program is so important ... it helps our clients learn responsibility while being held accountable, feeling loved, and building relationships that we hope will last through generations. It is heartbreaking and emotionally draining at times. However, walking through their journey of parenting with them is so rewarding! Karen Lohss is one of our longest-serving client advocates. She has been coming every



week for more than 10 years. This is a great example of Hebrews 12:1-3. "Don't get discouraged, fix your eyes on Jesus, and run with perseverance!" At Human Life Services, we value and appreciate all our volunteers and their talents. They are prayed for and loved, and we couldn't succeed without them!
