helping women and men through an unplanned pregnancy for nearly 40 years. In this time, you saw a shift of our services from 100% material resources to include educational classes, and then, free medical testing. Each addition was achieved through faith. Belief that if we sought to meet the needs of the community by following God's call to protect the unborn, He would bless the ministry with the people and funds to make it possible. As we stand at the threshold of tomorrow, we recognize a need to meet a growing list of clients with our services by renovating a space located on our property.

The old carriage house placed in the corner of our parking lot has been used for storage and sat relatively empty for years. We believe God is calling us to utilize the space to help an increasing number of clients in a life-affirming decision for their child! Plans for the development are underway and have gone through the York City zoning approval process. We are working to ensure it meets the historical outside appearance while being converted into a *new* **Educational Resource Center.** The new space will include a counseling and mentoring room, the client boutique, and a bathroom. Additionally, the space is both ADA and expectant mother friendly! This space also allows us to utilize the main building for increased medical appointments and group classes for men and women. In the words of one city board member, this is a win, win for the community.

Our goal is to be able to complete this project before the end of 2024. While HLS has seed money to start the project, it will require an additional pouring of support to complete the more than \$125,000 renovation. May the Lord speak to your heart as you pray on how an

Let us come to Him with Thanksgiving and praise Him for all those who come to Human Life Services. Two years ago, I met Talyn. She thought she came to us by mistake. She was searching for Planned Parenthood, and as a first-time mom, she was scared and didn't know if she could walk this path alone. However, she ended up calling HLS. We talked her through the emotions she was having, and she made an appointment for an ultrasound. This is when she got to see her baby and learn about the baby's growth at that stage of pregnancy. Talyn was excited to hear about our Care Program and the classes we offer and that the baby's father could come, too. They started their journey working full time on 3rd shift and coming to classes before heading to bed. They

may have been exhausted, but they loved coming to fellowship with us while being taught key pregnancy and parenting skills. This couple came to classes for 22 weeks and together learned things such as: what is safe in pregnancy, eating for two, labor and delivery, loving and practical discipline, being a role model and being a consistent dad.

They welcomed a little baby boy that June and immediately fell in love with their new bundle of joy! They quickly realized it wasn't easy to be a working parent/provider, but they were so thankful that we had an available client advocate so they could come back for our First Year and Life-Skills classes. Talyn really looked forward to earning "Baby Bucks" so she could get the items she needed for the baby. Through these years she was not only a client. She became family. We prayed together, talked about life, good and bad, and watched her baby grow and begin to walk.

Talyn was also involved in the Embrace Grace group that was held at a local church. She even offered to take another HLS client, also a young single mom, to the group because she didn't have a car. Talyn has grown so much in these past few years and is being the best mother she can be, while co-parenting her son. Life is hard, but finding the joys that come each day from God are the blessings we don't want to miss. It wasn't a mistake that she found us, but a blessing ... not only for her, but also for the



staff, her advocates, and all of the friends that she has made at HLS. We have that urgency to share God's love with them and pray for them during each visit. This is a great reminder, especially at this time of the year, of all the things God has done for us. He gives us protection, guidance, wisdom, love, and mercy every day. We continue to thank Him. Please pray for God's protection and provision in the physical and spiritual realms for all of our clients!

Did You Know?

Approximately 511,000 abortions were performed in the U.S. in only 6 months from January to June 2023 across 36 states.

PA ranked 8th highest.

How? Through compassionate medical care and weekly classes filled with grace, gentleness, and discipleship. It may be the woman who has an abortion in her past, or the young girl who feels a pregnancy will ruin her future plans, or the one filled with shame and child raising unbearable. It may be the couple who feels overwhelmed and financially strapped, the father who made a choice to parent alone,

and it can be the woman who has suffered abuse time and time again, afraid to bring a child into the world. **YOU** are part of their journey; a path to learning what it means to be joyful in all trials before us and the beautiful gift of life in the womb.

- Purchase a new ultrasound machine.
- Increase available hours for client appointments.

- **Increase marketing** to "reach her." Attended community fairs, festivals, and events. Handed out magnets and window clings with QR codes to our client website.
- **Trained** 3 medical staff on limited ultrasound sonography and sent 5 staff to training on all aspects of pregnancy center services, legal matters and medical best practices.
- Started a college campus outreach program.
