Decision making is a large part of our day. From the moment we open our eyes we make decisions. Some very small, and others much more life-altering. Even those with the strongest of faith can find themselves pressing pause in a state of confusion, fear, and indecisiveness. As Christians, those impactful decisions are tough and we seek the counsel of friends and family, but most importantly, God. He is our go-to and His word is our compass. Our decisions are often made utilizing our faith-based values, scripture, gained wisdom, and prayer. Lots and lots of prayer.

But what happens when individuals, with little to no understanding of how to rely on God in their decision-making process, are faced with an unplanned pregnancy? Most often the world becomes their counsel, and it is ready to provide abortion as the best

option. In York County, and only steps from Planned Parenthood, stands Human Life Services. This is God's design, and He is at work! We are His hands and feet, and we are ready to shine His light and expose them to the healing power of Christ. We are here to help.

Options Counseling is one of the most important aspects of our ministry. After pregnancy is confirmed, everything a woman feels, including a list of obstacles to raising a child, is shared in privacy. She can cry and pour out her deepest fears, shame, and concerns. Her counselor tenderly provides educational information on all her options - parenting, adoption, and the risks of abortion to all aspects of her health. The client can ask questions and learn about the development of her baby in the womb. It's an opportunity to see the heartbeat through an ultrasound. It's a time we can introduce God's ability to free them from all their fears! ~ Isaiah 43:1

You see, it is our vision to affirm all life and we strive to make abortion unthinkable through the love and compassion of Christ and His holy Word. It is our desire that no woman ever need to experience the pain of an abortion again. For many women, the memory of an abortion will never leave them. It may be unspoken. The memories may be suppressed, but, in the back of one's mind, a child they never knew is thought about. This can torment some, and studies show that it can lead to a lack of self-worth, addictions, prohibit future healthy relationships, and more. It is why we offer post abortion healing classes.

To help meet our vision, and as we look to our future after 39 years of service in York County, we embark on a large-scale renovation project that will increase our footprint and provide more room for Options Counseling, medical services, and designate a special space as an Educational Resource Room for parents and their children.

Thanks to you...In 2023

- 12 babies were SAVED!
- 28 babies born...14 of those were in our Care Program!
- 175 clients received Pregnancy Tests and Ultrasounds!
- 26 clients came in for STD testing!
- 3 women completed our post-abortion healing class!
- 162 sexual integrity lessons were presented at the YDC!
- 1,151 total appointments were kept by clients for medical services, as well as classes in our Care Program for our moms and dads!
- 29 clients were adopted in our Adopt-a-Client Christmas program!
- 33 individuals/groups gave towards our Christmas programs including donating items for the Star themed gift boxes given to our clients!



In the first 6 months of 2023, 511,000 abortions were performed across 36 states and DC. Pennsylvania ranks 8th in the entire United States. York County ranks 4th in the state for the most abortions. Pregnancy centers like HLS, helping to empower women and men in a decision for life continues to be a great need. There is still lots of work to do! The Christmas season is a very busy time of year. Preparing can be fun and exciting, but we know for some people it can be sad, overwhelming, and lonely. With the help of 20 donors, we were able to give hope to the clients who were adopted this year in our Adopt-A-Client Christmas program.

You may not know this, but we welcome clients of all ages. No matter what stage of parenting they are in, we are here to help. This year God sent us a few different types of opportunities to help clients. These clients are not young or unmarried, but they each had a great need for our services.

A newly married couple came to us late in their pregnancy needing support and knowledge. Praise God we were able to start them in classes right away. Their baby girl was due after Christmas, but their little blessing surprised them with instant joy three weeks early. She was an added present under the tree this year, along with the gifts they received from being in our Adopt-A-Client Christmas program. They have continued to come weekly and learn through our infant first year classes.

Another client, Denise, age 40, was in tears as gratitude flooded over her when receiving the gifts for herself and her children through the Christmas program. Denise ran from a domestic violence situation that led her to a place where she was unable to see her children and desperation kicked in as she sat in a local shelter. Thank God the shelter suggested she "get out and do something." This led her down

the street in our direction while getting some fresh air. She stopped outside our building and searched the internet to see what services we had to offer. She debated if she should call us or even come in as she was not a new mom. We welcomed Denise and immediately showered her with empathy, love, and compassion for the challenges life was throwing her way. She enrolled in our toddler classes and met weekly with an advocate who listened to her and mentored her during her difficult journey. Denise knew God sent her to HLS and finally had a glimpse of hope while prayers washed over her family. She was able to get out of the shelter with her newfound hope and started working again to provide a new life for her children. As a parent of two older teens, and now two toddlers, Denise was surprised by how much she appreciated her experience at HLS. "I never thought I would enjoy talking to a stranger or even desire to come to classes," she said. Seeing Denise so happy and thankful when receiving that showering of love through your donated gifts makes all our difficult days...worth it!

We were able to spread so much love and hope to our clients, which included those outside of our walls. Your generosity meant we could give to

those at a local maternity home and the York Youth Development Center, where we go weekly to teach them about sexual integrity.

We are encouraged by Psalm 100:5, which says, "For the Lord is good. His unfailing love continues forever, and His faithfulness continues to each generation."
