We are on track to excavate the parking lot, designate new handicapped parking spaces, install a new ADA accessible ramp to our main building and finish the interior design in September. Our goal is to host an Open House in October. Many thanks to Kinsley and Campbell Construction for their design, service work and oversight of contractors on this project. We thank them for their many cost-saving efforts.
