The Nurse Manager will:

- Perform limited ultrasounds when needed (training provided).
- Complete and oversee completion of client charting.
- Oversee client follow-up per plan of care and standardized procedures.
- Make follow calls to clients to track outcomes.
- Update OSHA/Private Information Policy compliance yearly.
- Train, volunteers and staff on safety procedures and deliver changes to policies and procedures.
- Represent the clinic in the community as delegated by the Executive Director.

Minimum qualifications include:

- Be a committed Christian who demonstrates an active personal relationship with Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.
- Affirm full agreement with the organization's Mission Statement and Statement of Principles.
- Exhibit a strong commitment and dedication to the pro-life position and sexual purity, never referring or recommending that a woman have an abortion.
- Have a sincere desire to reach out to abortion-vulnerable and abortion-minded women and men.
- Exhibit skills in human relations, written and oral communication, and possess the ability to work in a collaborative setting.
- Respect the authority roles God has placed at the ministry.
- Preferred Registered Nursing license but not required.
- Two years of clinical experience with an emphasis on obstetrical and gynecological care is preferred but not required.
- Must be willing to obtain any training required to demonstrate competency in limited obstetrical ultrasounds.
- A Registered Diagnostic Medical Sonographer (RDMS) license in good standing with the American Registry of Diagnostic Medical Sonographers.
