

Easter is one of my most treasured holidays of the Christian Faith. It's a time to immerse in deep reflection on God's love. Me, He loves me, and I am His child. He provides a path to receive the greatest gift, eternal life with Him in heaven. Most of our clients have never learned enough scripture to know this for themselves. It is another reason why our work is important. I was blessed by parents who were saved in Christ and instilled the message of salvation within me. There were times when I sinned and wondered if God would forgive me. I can remember asking my mother; "Is my sin so great that I am now lost?" I recall one such conversation, she said, "Leona, the greatest thing I have ever done in my life was to become a mother. No matter how you disobey, I love you, and you love

me. That unconditional love is the most beautiful of all our human emotions. This is how God loves you, and how we are to love others. Ask for forgiveness and it is yours." That hit me like a brick, I deeply needed to hear those words.

Today, I think of the women and men who have been, and currently are, clients of Human Life Services. I think of the overwhelming fear of becoming a parent. It can scare one away from choosing life for their child. In despair and feelings of unworthiness, those without spiritual mentors easily compound poor decision making until they ask themselves the same question I did. I've heard it said over and over; "I can barely love myself, how can I love a child, and how can God love me?" They do not fathom how an abortion can steal an opportunity to feel earthly agape love and it can delay or block their ability to feel it with God. In 1 Peter we read of encouragement for Christians to persevere in a "lively hope" to overcome trials, sufferings and grief of all kinds through our immense love for God and His love for us. We are told that our faith/hope is more precious than gold. What a powerful tangible statement. Yet, we should not keep this to ourselves. Chapter 1, verses 22-23, says we are to love one another with a pure heart, fervently! We do so by being born again and living through the Word of God. The ministry of HLS begins by providing loving alternatives to abortion and it continues by providing opportunities for prayer, scripture, and a message of salvation to our clients in every interaction. We desire for them to know Christ personally and continue the transformation in their personal lives. Praise to God, for the word of the Lord is preached and endures forever!

Dads are such an important part of the family. I can remember so many wonderful memories of my dad. I may not have liked all the shopping trips to Lowe's due to walking down every aisle to look at everything. However, I realized this taught me that I never have to ask where something is while in the store... I will find it, eventually!! I now miss this extra quality time I had to talk to him, plan projects, and learn skills I would use later in life. He loved his family enough to lead us in the Lord. He was always so proud to see his grandchildren... especially at church on Sunday mornings when they would run up to him for big hugs. These are now cherished memories as my dad went to heaven way too

early for me. My family treasures all of these precious moments God gave us with him. He was not perfect, but he left a good example of what to pass on to future generations. We are to follow God's vision for teaching multiple generations as taught in Psalm 78:5-7 and Deuteronomy 4:9.

What words come to mind when you think of a good dad? Loving, protective, strong, dependable, wise, supportive? These are all characteristics that we hoped or wished our dads had. Some of you may not have had a father like mine who learned this parenting style, or maybe your fathers weren't shown how to parent with love. We need to help give this knowledge to dads because God has a high standard for the fathers in the household. The Bible says they were chosen by God to lead their families (Genesis 18:19). Fathers are charged to be protectors by putting on the full armor of God (Ephesians 6:11-18). In 1 Kings 15:11 it shows he is to be a good example and an irreplaceable asset to his children. Taking his children by the hand and guiding them with wisdom (Ephesians 6:4). Great dads are the backbone to the family unit, providing a steady foundation (Ephesians 5:25-37, 1 Corinthians 16:13-14). He is to be invested in his children, being their biggest cheerleader, but the most important of these is showing unconditional LOVE. This becomes a template for his children when they are seeking relationships. Also, fathers are to reflect God's unique love. Being made in our Heavenly Father's likeness (Genesis 1:26-28). we bear the likeness of our fathers. Having compassion on his children, so the Lord has compassion on those who fear Him (Psalm 103:13).

Do you see how important Dads are? This is why HLS has decided to have a dad's group... Determined Dads! We want to reinforce the importance of dads, so they learn how to provide a stable and nurturing environment for their children. We want to teach them how to equip their

children with the knowledge and understanding of God's Word. The Determined Dads group will have monthly classes where male advocates and men from the community can get together and go over important and sometimes very hard topics. Imagine if we can start training up more men who are determined to be better than their dads were, determined to learn how to correctly discipline and show love to their children, and determined to parent with knowledge to change

the path of a generational curse... determined to be the man God intended him to be, in all aspects of life. This group will build bonds in the hopes of passing the torch of Faith to their children!
